2018 New Year's Resolution: Read Your Bible

The Baptist Faith and Message has this to say about the Bible:

The Holy Bible was written by men divinely inspired and is God's revelation of Himself to man. It is a perfect treasure of divine instruction. It has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth, without any mixture of error, for its matter. Therefore, all Scripture is totally true and trustworthy.

We affirm that the Bible is the divine and perfect revelation of God to us. Because this is true, there is nothing more profitable for promoting growth in Christ-likeness and love for God than reading the Bible. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 says, "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." Putting these two ideas together leads us to the conclusion that reading all of the Bible is a task every Christian should aim for. To that end, I want to challenge you to use 2018 as a time to read through the entire Bible. You might feel overwhelmed by that task, but if you spent 15 minutes a day reading your Bible, you could read it in less than 10 months!

One of the best tools for helping you accomplish the goal of reading through the entire Bible is a Bible reading plan. A reading plan clearly sets out what you should read each day. This takes away the guess work for you, and it helps you break up the Bible into smaller chunks. Below, I have listed different Bible reading plans and where you can go to download them. 
